North Burlingham is a hidden gem along the Acle straight, nestled between Brundall and Great Yarmouth. Likened to a fairy wood by the DRAGONS, the enchanting trail is abundant with wildlife, and colour thanks to various pieces of artwork.

There are no disabled-friendly facilities on-site. There is parking available either outside the church or on the road, however the road can be very bumpy and uneven.

The walk itself has hard surfaces, but there can be obstacles such as tree routes. Points of interest include the church, a paddock, and a book exchange. Whilst there are no refreshments on-site, the nearest stop is Fairhaven cafe.
